INSTRUCTIONS

A) Placing treemat up to 2 months before the dry season of your region



1. Place the TreeDiaper® treemats on top of soil around plants. Leave Space between teemats and trunk. Make sure the pellets inside the treemats are evenly distributed. Trick: Soaking for 15 min makes it easier to evenly distribute the pellets.




2. Cover with 2" of mulch to disguise protect the TreeDiaper® treemats. **DO NOT** cover with soil. Mulch along the contour of treemats and the surrounding soil to form a mulch ring. Staples can be used to fix to ground, but leave space for it grow.



3. Water trees when soil moisture is low OR if wilting or yellow leaves appear. Use soil moisture meter to check soil moisture once every two to three (2-3) weeks if there is less than 1" of rain.

B) Placing treemat during or less than two months before drought



1. Place the TreeDiaper® treemats completely submerged in water for 2-4 hours. When soft water (e.g. rainwater) is used, do not soak for more than 4 hours.


2. Follow steps 1-3 from Procedure A.

Using treemat with an irrigation system

- 1. Follow Procedure A or B
- Let drip irrigation water the top of the treemat or the top of mulch.



The size of TreeDiaper® treemats should be double or at least 20 inches larger than the rootball sizes!



NOTES:

- · Always place the mat directly on top of the soil with the darker black woven side facing up!
- · Covering with coarse structured mulch materials is highly recommended. **DO NOT** place TreeDiaper® treemats on top of mulch!
- · Do not place any soil, dirt, fine sand or compost on top of TreeDiaper® treemats. This may result in the loss of functionalities.
- Direct contact of fertilizers, iron rusts, or deicing salts with the material in use or in storage may temporarily or permanently affect the performance of the products.
- · Avoid damages to TreeDiaper® products by tools and lawn-care equipment. Damaged surface integrity may decrease the functionality of the products. If accidentally damaged, do not throw away. Cover with more mulch, it shall continue to function to a certain degree depending on the severity of the damage.
- · Leave TreeDiaper® treemats outdoor during winter time!
